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

CAUTION OR IMPORTANT

USE BOLT SEALANT



Apply 3 to 4 small drops of bolt sealant onto the cleaned and degreased threads before tightening the bolts.

WARNING! Avoid contact with skin, eyes and mucous membranes. Do not inhale fumes. Keep out of reach of children.



USE ANTI-SEIZE LEAD-FREE COPPER PASTE (black tube)

Provides trouble-free and long-lasting protection against seizing, corrosion and rusting of bolts, threaded ends, nuts, joints, etc. Also protects against vibration, wear and impact.

WARNING! Avoid eye contact. Keep out of reach of children.



USE ANTI-SEIZING GREASE (white tube)

Prevents seizing, corrosion and excessive wear between the titanium components of your exhaust system.

In case your Akrapovič exhaust system may not be used on certain roads or under certain conditions, please keep the stock or other exhaust system that you can use in such circumstances legally.



REMOVAL OF STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM:

- 1. Put the motorcycle on a side stand, we recommend a central racing stand. Make sure, that surface is solid and flat.
- 2. Unscrew the marked bolts and remove the lower part of the header's bracket (F 01).
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 3. Unscrew the lambda sensor (F 02).
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure not to damage the sensor or the sensor's electrical lead during this process!




- 4. Unscrew the marked nuts (F 03).
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- 5. Unscrew the marked muffler's bracket bolt and carefully remove the stock exhaust off the motorcycle (F 04).
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- Carefully remove the upper part of the header's bracket out of the rubber damper (F 05).
- INSTALLATION TIP: for easier dismounting, lubricate the rubber damper (WD-40*)! *WD- $40^{\mbox{\scriptsize (B)}}$ is a trademark of the WD-40 Company.



INSTALLATION OF THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEM: 1. Set up the flange with the springs and sleeve, as shown (F 06).




- 2. Set up and hand tighten the flange together with the springs and sleeve onto the cylinder head, using stock nuts; make sure you orient the flanges and springs as shown (F 07).
- ! IMPORTANT: do not fully tighten the flange yet!
- > INSTALLATION TIP: use new stock exhaust port gasket.



- 3. Install the upper part of the Akrapovič header's bracket into the rubber damper (F 08).
- INSTALLATION TIP: for easier mounting, lubricate the rubber damper (WD-40*)!



- 4. Carefully Install the header tube onto the motorcycle, attach the springs and hand tighten the Akrapovič lower part of the header bracket **(F 09, 10, 11).**
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure, that springs pull the header tube all the way into the sleeve use rubber mallet if necessary to tap the connection into place!





! IMPORTANT: do not fully tighten the header's bracket yet!



- 5. **For G 310 GS model only:** install the lower part of the Akrapovič header's bracket into the rubber damper and hand tighten the upper part of the header bracket **(F 12, 13).**
- INSTALLATION TIP: for easier mounting, lubricate the rubber damper (WD-40*)!


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! IMPORTANT: do not fully tighten the header's bracket yet!



- 6. Tighten the lambda sensor into the header (F 14).
- **M** IMPORTANT: make sure not to damage the sensor or sensor's electrical lead during this process!




- 7. Correctly position the carbon-fiber clamp and slide it onto the muffler bear in mind the **right offset** of the carbon fiber- clamp; check the correct position of the yellow sticker on the clamp **(F 15, 16)**.
- ! IMPORTANT: open the clamp slightly wider than the diameter of the outer sleeve of the muffler do not scrape it along the muffler outer sleeve!









- 8. Position the muffler correctly and slide it onto the outlet side of the header; attach the springs, align the muffler in respect to the motorcycle and tighten the muffler onto the muffler's bracket using bolt, Alu spacer, washer and nut from Akrapovič installation kit (F 17, 18).
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!





- 9. Tighten the flange nuts and header bracket bolts to a specified torque (F 19, 20, 21, 22).
- CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!

FINAL INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE:

Clean grease spots off all exhaust system surfaces, when installation is finished. Cleaning will prevent spots from burning onto the surface. Do not use aggressive chemical cleaners, because they can damage the surface or sticker.

- 1. Muffler titanium outer sleeve: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40[®] or equivalent)*.
- 2. Muffler carbon-fiber outer sleeve: use a soft dry cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 3. Muffler carbon-fiber outlet cap: use a soft dry cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 4. Painted mufflers and parts use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 5. Chrome plated mufflers and parts: use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 6. Stainless steel pipes: use a soft cloth sprayed with a contact cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 7. Titanium pipes: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40[®] or equivalent)*.

Periodically make sure all the bolts and springs are sufficiently tight.

- IMPORTANT: make sure all the bolts are sufficiently tightened. In case the exhaust system touches the cowling or other parts repeat the adjustment of the exhaust system or contact your authorized dealer!
- CAUTION: after running engine for 30 minutes, retighten the bolts of the Akrapovič carbon-fiber heat shield!
- INSTALLATION TIP: IT IS NORMAL IF WHITE SMOKE COMES OUT OF THE MUFFLER DURING THE FIRST 100 KM AFTER REPLACEMENT.
- INSTALLATION TIP: A CHANGE IN THE COLOR OF THE EXHAUST SYSTEM IS NORMAL DUE TO THE HIGH TEMPERATURES.
- CAUTION: DO NOT STAND BEHIND THE MUFFLER AT ANY TIME.
- IMPORTANT: DO NOT USE AUTOMOTIVE WHEEL CLEANERS OR ANY CLEANING PRODUCTS
 WHICH CONTAIN ACIDIC ADDITIVES TO CLEAN AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEMS.

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

CAUTION OR IMPORTANT

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- T-handle 5 mm hexagon wrench
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- T-handle 13 mm wrench
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- Bi-hex 10 mm socket
- Combination 22 mm wrench

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- 1. Put the motorcycle on a side stand, we recommend a central racing stand. Make sure, that surface is solid and flat.
- 2. Unscrew the marked bolts and remove the lower part of the header's bracket (F 01).
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 3. Unscrew the lambda sensor (F 02).
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure not to damage the sensor or the sensor's electrical lead during this process!



- 4. Unscrew the marked nuts (F 03).



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

- 3. Install the upper part of the Akrapovič header's bracket into the rubber damper (F 08).
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
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- 4. Carefully Install the header tube onto the motorcycle, attach the springs and hand tighten the Akrapovič lower part of the header bracket **(F 09, 10, 11).**
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure, that springs pull the header tube all the way into the sleeve use rubber mallet if necessary to tap the connection into place!





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- 5. Tighten the lambda sensor into the header (F 12).
- MPORTANT: make sure not to damage the sensor or sensor's electrical lead during this process!






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
- 7. Position the muffler correctly and slide it onto the outlet side of the header; attach the springs, align the muffler in respect to the motorcycle and tighten the muffler onto the muffler's bracket using bolt, Alu spacer, washer and nut from Akrapovič installation kit (F 15, 16).
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!









- 8. Tighten the flange nuts and header bracket bolts to a specified torque (F 17, 18, 19).
- CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!







FINAL INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE:
