

 DESIGNED. INSTALLATION PROCEDURES VARY DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF MOTORCYCLE. PLEASE
 VERIFY THAT THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEM AND THIS INSTALLATION MANUAL CORRESPOND
 TO THE TYPE OF YOUR MOTORCYCLE.
- THE EXHAUST SYSTEM CAN GET EXTREMELY HOT DURING AND AFTER IT IS USED. MAKE SURE NOT TO

CAUTION OR IMPORTANT

USE BOLT SEALANT



Apply 3 to 4 small drops of bolt sealant onto the cleaned and degreased threads before tightening the bolts.

WARNING! Avoid contact with skin, eyes and mucous membranes. Do not inhale fumes. Keep out of reach of children.



USE ANTI-SEIZE LEAD-FREE COPPER PASTE (black tube)

Provides trouble-free and long-lasting protection against seizing, corrosion and rusting of bolts, threaded ends, nuts, joints, etc. Also protects against vibration, wear and impact.

WARNING! Avoid eye contact. Keep out of reach of children.



USE ANTI-SEIZING GREASE (white tube)

Prevents seizing, corrosion and excessive wear between the titanium components of your exhaust system.

Akrapovič shall not assume any liability or responsibility with regard to uninstalling your existing exhaust system, warranty coverage of such exhaust system or vehicle or their further fitness for use.

In case your Akrapovič exhaust system may not be used on certain roads or under certain conditions, please keep the stock or other exhaust system that you can use in such circumstances legally.



REMOVAL OF STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM NINJA H2R:


- 1. Put the motorcycle on a side stand, we recommend a central racing stand. Make sure, that surface is solid and flat.
- 2. Unhook two marked springs, unscrew marked bolt and remove the stock muffler off the motorcycle (F 01).
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 3. Unhook two springs (marked with the bottom arrow), unscrew marked bolt and remove stock link pipe off the motorcycle (F 02).
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 4. Removal of stock collectors and headers can be achieved in one single step. Unscrew 8 nuts attaching headers to the motorcycle. Then carefully remove stock headers from the motorcycle (F 03).
- IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage the radiator or any other part of the motorcycle during this process!
- INSTALLATION TIP: you can protect radiator core with duct tape!



- 5. Unscrew marked bolts, unhook hose and remove stock bracket off the motorcycle. The rubber hose grommet should stay on the hose (F 04).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!





REMOVAL OF STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM NINJA H2:

- 1. Put the motorcycle on a side stand, we recommend a central racing stand. Make sure, that surface is solid and flat.
- 2. Unscrew marked bolt and carefully remove upper heat shield off the motorcycle (F 05).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 3. Unscrew marked bolts and remove lower heat shield off the motorcycle (F 06).
- IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 4. Loosen the metal clamp at the muffler-link pipe connection, unscrew the muffler hanging bracket bolt and remove muffler off the motorcycle (F 07).
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 5. Unscrew marked bolts and remove muffler's bracket off the motorcycle (F 08).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!





- 6. Unscrew marked bolts, unhook hose and remove stock remote spring preload adjuster's bracket off the motorcycle. The rubber hose grommet should stay on the hose (F 09).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



7. Use motorcycle's key to unlock and remove the back rest of the seat (F 10).



- 8. Once back rest is removed, unscrew the market bolts. This will enable you to remove leather sitting area (F 11).
- IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 9. Unscrew the marked bolts in order to remove the left and right side panels (in total 4 panels). Please note that locations of the bolts are simetrical on each side (F 12).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!






- 10. Further deinstalation requires lifting of the fuel tank cover. Unscrew marked bolts, as shown (F 13).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



11. Remove the battery by releasing the spring and unscrewing the negative and positive contact points, as shown **(F 14)**.



- 12. Lift the the fuel tank and support it with some gentle spacer (we used rubber mallet), as shown (F 15).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 13. Now you have access to the servo motor, which operates the exhaust valves. Unscrew marked bolt and carefully lift up the servo motor's cover (F 16).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!






- 14. Remove the cable safety protection, unscrew marked bolt and remove the cables (**F 17**). Note that cables are still fixed on another side to the stock link pipe, which is alright. Link pipe will be removed together with the cables. Reinstall valve's servo motor cover, battery, fuel tank cover, pannels and seat back onto the motorcycle in reverse order from the order in which it was removed.
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 15. Before completely removing the stock exhaust unscrew lambda sensor and marked bolt (F 18).
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure not to damage the lambda sensor's electrical lead during this procedure!



- 16. Removal of stock exhaust can be achieved in one single step. Unscrew 8 nuts attaching headers to the motorcycle and carefully remove stock exhaust from the motorcycle (F 19).
- IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage the radiator or any other part of the motorcycle during this process!
- INSTALLATION TIP: you can protect radiator core with duct tape!




INSTALLATION OF THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEM:

- 1. Prepaire and position Akrapovič headers correctly onto the cylinder head outlets and slide them in. Hand tighten the headers only (F 20, 21, 22).
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure, that springs pull the collectors all the way onto the headers use rubber mallet if necessary to tap the connections into place!
- INSTALLATION TIP: coat the interior side of the inlet bushes of the titanium collectors with Akrapovič ceramic anti-seizing grease (white tube).





IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage the radiator or any other part of the motorcycle during this process!



- 2. **For Ninja H2R model only:** To remove the original stock exhaust bracket, firstly remove two marked bolts of foot rest bracket. This will make foot rest bracket partially movable, enough to gain place for removal of the stock exhaust bracket **(F 23)**.
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 3. **For Ninja H2R model only:** Unscrew marked bolt, which is behind the foot rest bracket. Then remove the bracket and tighten back the bolt **(F 24)**.
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!




- 4. For Ninja H2R model only: Apply some bolt sealant and tighten back all the unscrewed bolts from step 2 (F 25).
- IMPORTANT: use bolt sealant on all bolt threads!




- 5. Slide Akrapovič link pipe correctly into the collector's outlet and attach it with two springs from Akrapovič installation kit (F 26).
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure, that springs pull the link pipe all the way onto the collectors use rubber mallet if necessary to tap the connections into place!
- INSTALLATION TIP: coat the interior side of the inlet bushes of the titanium collectors with Akrapovič ceramic anti-seizing grease (white tube).



6. For Ninja H2 model only: Remove the plug which will be replaced by lambda sensor (F 27).



- 7. For Ninja H2 model only: Install the lambda sensor into the link pipe, as shown (F 28).
- IMPORTANT: make sure not to damage the lambda sensor's electrical lead during this procedure!



- 8. Assemble Akrapovič bracket and remote spring preload adjuster as shown, using stock bolts, washers and nuts. Mount rubber hose grommet with inserted hose into the bracket's hook **(F 29)**.
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!




- Install the Carbon Fiber Bracket onto the right hand side of the sub frame, using 2 bolts and 2 washers from Akrapovič installation kit, as shown. Place remote spring preload adjuster bracket between sub frame and Carbon Fibre Bracket (F 30).
- ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



10. Install the clamp from Akrapovič installation kit onto the muffler's inlet, as shown (F 31).



- 11. Position the muffler correctly and slide it onto the outlet of the stock collector. Align the muffler in respect to the motorcycle and tighten the muffler bracket to the right side of the Carbon Fiber Bracket using material from Akrapovič installation kit (a bolt, two washers and a nut). Tighten the header flanges to the specified torque (F 32).
- IMPORTANT: remove all the duct tape from radiator's core, if you used it!
- ! CAUTION: be careful not to injure yourself or damage any part of the motorcycle during this procedure!



- 12. Remove marked warning sticker "DO NOT UNFASTEN" from the muffler, before first use (F 33).
- IMPORTANT: do not untighten glued muffler bracket bolts in any case!



FINAL INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE:

Clean grease spots off all exhaust system surfaces, when installation is finished. Cleaning will prevent spots from burning onto the surface. Do not use aggressive chemical cleaners, because they can damage the surface or sticker.

- 1. Muffler titanium outer sleeve: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40[®] or equivalent)*.
- 2. Muffler carbon-fiber outer sleeve: use a soft dry cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 3. Muffler carbon-fiber outlet cap: use a soft dry cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 4. Painted mufflers and parts use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 5. Chrome plated mufflers and parts: use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 6. Stainless steel pipes: use a soft cloth sprayed with a contact cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 7. Titanium pipes: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40[®] or equivalent)*.

Periodically make sure all the bolts and springs are sufficiently tight.

- IMPORTANT: make sure all the bolts are sufficiently tightened. In case the exhaust system touches the cowling or other parts repeat the adjustment of the exhaust system or contact your authorized dealer!
- CAUTION: after running engine for 30 minutes, retighten the bolts of the Akrapovič carbon-fiber heat shield!
- INSTALLATION TIP: IT IS NORMAL IF WHITE SMOKE COMES OUT OF THE MUFFLER DURING THE FIRST 100 KM AFTER REPLACEMENT.
- INSTALLATION TIP: A CHANGE IN THE COLOR OF THE EXHAUST SYSTEM IS NORMAL DUE TO THE HIGH TEMPERATURES.
- CAUTION: DO NOT STAND BEHIND THE MUFFLER AT ANY TIME.
- IMPORTANT: DO NOT USE AUTOMOTIVE WHEEL CLEANERS OR ANY CLEANING PRODUCTS WHICH CONTAIN ACIDIC ADDITIVES TO CLEAN AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEMS.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Exhaust gas leaks out of the muffler/pipe clamp connections	loosened clamp	tighten the clamp to specified torque
	connection is not completely joined	tap the connection into place and tighten the clamp to specified torque
