Remove tough deposits with a **Cleaning Brush**.

Remove oxidation from snowmobile tunnels with **Snowmobile Tunnel Cleaner**.

Clean and de-fog helmet, goggles and windshield with **Goggles Cleaner**.

Follow up with an application of SledBrite Belly Pan with **Snowmobile Polish** for shine and protection.

DIRECTIONS: Spray on, let set for 1-5 minutes, wipe or rinse off. Tough deposits may require agitation with a damp cloth or a stiff bristle brush and longer dwell time. Deposits left for long periods may have baked into the plastic and may not be entirely removable.
