

- * Read all instructions carefully and completely before installing your new Cobra freeway bar *
- 1. Unbolt the front bolt only from left side rider foot peg/floorboard bracket and set aside for future assembling.
- Unbolt the right side rider foot peg/floorboard bracket and set the bolts aside for future assembling. Unbolt the rear brake master cylinder assembly from the frame; the bolts for rear brake master cylinder will be replaced with 8mm X 25mm button heads (supplied).
- 3. Find the two (2) front bolts for the motor mount; this is where the top freeway bar bracket will mount on both sides. Remove the stock bolts and save.
- 4. Install the supplied spacer bracket between the rear brake master cylinder assembly and the bottom frame rail using the two (2) supplied M8 x 25mm Button Head Bolts (see figure 1).
- 5. Install the single short spacer between the rear hole on the foot peg/floorboard bracket and the bottom frame rail using the stock bolt. There will be a gap between front hole and frame that the freeway bar bracket will fill in next step. **FINGER TIGHTEN ONLY.**
- Install the freeway bar by placing the lower right bracket between the right foot peg/floorboard bracket and the frame using the stock bolt. Then, place the left freeway bar bracket on top of the left foot peg/floorboard bracket using the stock bolt.
- 7. Install top of the freeway bar using the previously removed stock bolts mentioned in step 3.
- 8. Tighten all hardware to factory torque specifications (pay special attention to rear brake master cylinder).
 - * Before riding vehicle make sure rear brake operates properly *
