- STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool. Remove main fuse.

NOTICE A FACTORY SERVICE MANUAL MAY BE HELPFUL IN PERFORMING THIS INSTALLATION. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PERFORM THIS INSTALLATION IF YOU ARE NOT CONFIDENT IN YOUR ABILITY TO COMPLETE ALL OF THE STEPS IN THE PROCEDURE; CONSULT A TRAINED TECHNICIAN.

- STEP 2** Test the horn. The horn should sound the same with the new Horn Cover installed.

- STEP 3** Remove the acorn nut and washer that attaches the stock horn to the rubber mount on the motorcycle. Set hardware aside, it will NOT be reused.

- STEP 4** Refer to PIC 2. Remove the flange nut that secures the horn to the stock mount and cover. Pay attention to the position of the wire connections and the bell. This will be installed on the new bracket in the same orientation. Set the flange nut aside, it will be reused. Remove the horn from the stock cover.



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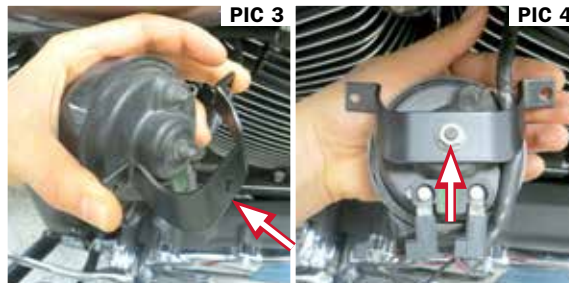
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- STEP 5** Refer to PIC 3 and 4. Locate provided Bracket. Fasten the horn to the bracket using the flange nut that was removed in Step 4. Be sure the wire harness is located between the back of the horn and bracket, and the terminal connect points are pointing down towards the ground.

TORQUE VALUE FOR FLANGE NUT:
80-100 IN-LBS (9-11.3 NM)



- STEP 6** Refer to PIC 5. Locate provided Horn Cover and two (2) Button Head Cap Screws. Fasten the horn and bracket assembly to the Horn Cover.



- STEP 7** Refer to PIC 6. Locate provided Barrel Nut. Fasten it to the rubber mount stud, from where the existing horn cover was removed from.

TORQUE VALUE FOR BARREL NUT:
35-55 IN-LBS (3.9-6.2 NM)



- STEP 8** Refer to PIC 8 and 9. Locate provided internal tooth lock washer and socket head cap screw. Insert the screw through the mounting hole on the front top side of the horn cover. On the inside of the horn cover, thread the lock washer onto the screw.



- STEP 9** Refer to PIC 10. Align the horn cover assembly over the barrel nut. Fasten assembly to the barrel nut. Fully tighten hardware.

TORQUE VALUE FOR SOCKET SCREW:
80-120 IN-LBS (9-13.6 NM)



- STEP 10** Reinstall main fuse and test the horn.
