Flat Head Screwdriver

PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Loosen the two clamps on the front heat shield, labeled as "A" in <u>PIC.1</u>, as much as possible without the clamps coming undone.

STEP 2 Loosen the two clamps on the middle head shield, labeled as "B" in <u>PIC.1</u>, until the end of the clamp comes free from the threaded tightening mechanism. Remove the middle heat shield entirely if you prefer, but it is not necessary. Rotate the middle heat shield down and slide it towards the rear of the bike to gain the clearance needed to install the "Bridge the Gap" Heat Shield. See <u>PIC.2</u>.

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
STEP 3 Insert the longer end of the "Bridge the Gap" Heat Shield under the lower end of the front heat shield. Make sure the end comes to rest under the lower clamp of the front heat shield.

STEP 4 Maneuver the rear end of the "Bridge the Gap" Heat Shield into position under the middle heat shield's forward most clamp.

STEP 5 Move the middle heat shield

back into position and tighten the clamps just enough to hold it in place.

step 6 Line up all the heat shields so the seams are as inconspicuous as possible. Start by lining up the middle heat shield with the rear heat shield and work forward. When you have the shields in the preferred position, tightening each fully. See PIC.3.
