
EE Suzuki Skidplate Installation

- Using an 8mm socket remove the stock plastic engine guards (see figures 1.0-1.1). Your new Aluminum skid plate will take the place of these plastic guards.
- Install the rear clamp over the lower frame cross-member (see figures 2.0-2.1).
- Position the front strap into place, you will need to hold this in place until you get the front bolts started (see figure 3.0).
- Position the skid plate against the frame and install the two supplied 8x45mm flat head bolts, only finger tighten at this time (see figure 4.0).
- Press skid plate up against the frame and install the two supplied 8x35mm flat head bolts into the rear clamp, only finger tighten at this time (see figure 5.0).
- After all mounting bolts have been started, using a 5mm Allen, tighten them evenly alternating from front to back until skid plate is secure (see figure 6.0).
