



## EVO 2 ROOST DEFLECTOR INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1** First determine the right side deflector from the left side deflector. The EE sticker is on the top of each deflector with the arrows pointed inwards.
- 2** If your Enduro Engineering Debris Deflectors have the two mounting holes as shown in [ Fig. 1 ] go to step 3 through 6. If not proceed to step 7.
- 3** Hold the Roost deflector up against the Debris Deflector, matching the contour of the plastic deflector to the contour of the aluminum Debris Deflector. [ Fig. 2 ]
- 4** Hold the front deflector plate against the Debris Deflector. [ Fig. 3 ]
- 5** Using 2 of the supplied M5x16 flat head bolts, fasten the front deflector plate and EVO 2 Roost Deflector to the Debris Deflector. [ Fig. 4 ] Evenly tighten using a 3MM Allen wrench.
- 6** Repeat steps 2 through 5 for the other EVO 2 Roost Deflector.
- 7** Hold the EVO 2 Roost Deflector up to the Debris Deflector as a template. Now mark the two spots that are to be drilled. [ Fig. 5 ]
- 8** Using the supplied No. 16 drill bit, drill the two holes you just marked. [ Fig. 6 ]
- 9** Hold the Roost deflector up against the Debris Deflector, matching the contour of the plastic deflector to the contour of the aluminum Debris Deflector. [ Fig. 2 ]
- 10** Hold the front deflector plate against the Debris Deflector. [ Fig. 3 ]
- 11** Using 2 of the supplied self-tapping Phillips screws, fasten the front deflector plate then and EVO 2 Roost Deflector to the Debris Deflector. [ Fig. 7 ] Evenly tighten with a Phillips head screw driver.
- 12** Repeat steps 7 through 11 for the other EVO 2 Roost Deflector.
