Do not overload Jack stands beyond rated capacity. Overloading can cause damage to or failure of the jack stands and bodily harm. Position load on center of saddle only. Always use stands on hard level surface capable of sustaining the load. Use of stands on anything other than a hard level surface can result in stand instability and possible loss of load. It is recommended when lifting front end or back end of vehicle to use a pair of matching jack stands.

Maintenance & Inspection

- 1. Visual Inspection shall be made before each use of the stands, checking for cracks, cracked welds and missing and / or damaged parts. Any stand that appears to be damaged in any way should be removed from service immediately.
- 2. Because of the potential hazards associated with the misuse of equipment of this type, no modifications should be made of the product without consent from manufacturer.

Operation




NOTE: NEVER use Jack Stands to support both ends or one side of a vehicle. Use only one (1) pair per vehicle. Rated Capacity is per stand only. DO NOT exceed rated capacity.

1. Refer to your vehicle owner's manual for proper jacking procedures. Lift only on areas of the vehicle specified by the vehicle manufacturer.



NOTE: Only attachments and/or adapters supplied by the manufacturer shall be used with these jack stands. please consult with manufacturer for approved accessories for these jack stands.

- 2. Position stands under vehicle at points specified by the vehicle manufacturer as proper load support points.
- 3. To adjust stands:
 - 1. Remove HD Linchpin and chained pin and adjust to the desired height.
 - 2. Place chained pin into hole location and attach the *HD* Linchpin and lock pin in.
 - 3. Carefully lower load onto stands.





HD LINCHPIN:

Proper Connection of the Linchpin to the chained pin as seen above. Please make sure when receiving this product all parts are included.
