Model HSHD-01

Application 2014 and earlier Softail – 2014 and earlier Dyna – 83 to 2003 Sportster – 86 to 2007 FLHT/FLTR (All touring models)

Model HSHD-02

Application 2008-2013 FLHT/FLTR (all touring models) 2015 and later Softail, 2015 and later Dynas, 2016 Dyna Low Rider S

Model HSHD-03

Application All years V-Rod, All Screaming Eagle, 2014 and later FLHT/FLTR (all touring models) and Harley Davidsons with hydraulic clutch, Fatboy S, Softail Slim S

Model HSHD-04

Application 2004 and later Sportsters

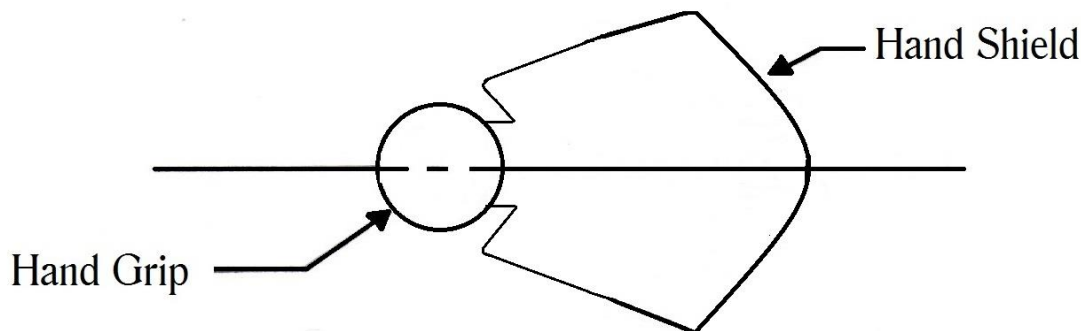
Installation Instructions

1. Remove the rear view mirrors from the motorcycle.
2. The Hand Shields are not interchangeable. The clutch side has the Great Bike Gear logo on the interior. Position the Hand Shield mounting holes over the rear view mirror mounting holes on the controls.
3. Reinstall the rear view mirrors through the mounting holes in the Hand Guard and the controls. Adjust the Hand Shield to provide hand clearance with a heavy glove from the lever to the inside of the Hand Shield prior to tightening the mirror nut.
4. The controls may need to be rotated to achieve the optimum efficiency. See sketch below.
