INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Make sure the motorcycle is cool and place securely on a service lift or stand.
- 2) Remove the two bolts securing the midpipe heat shield to the stock muffler. (Fig. 1)
- **3)** Loosen the clamp securing the muffler inlet to the headpipe outlet.
- **4)** Remove the bolt, and nut, securing the stock muffler to the passenger peg mount. (Fig. 1)
- **5)** Remove the stock muffler assembly from the motorcycle.
- **6)** Place the supplied T-Bolt Clamp onto the notched inlet of the new Midpipe.
- **7)** Slide the new Midpipe over the stock headpipe outlet, until fully seated.
- 8) Slide the new RT-5 Muffler onto the midpipe until fully seated. Using the supplied M8-1.25x20mm Hex Flange Head Bolt, and original nut, loosely secure the muffler to the passenger peg mount. (Fig. 2)
- **9)** Secure the muffler to the midpipe using the supplied Swivel Spring.
- 10) Position the exhaust system in the best possible orientation, then fully tighten the t-bolt clamp and muffler mounting hardware.

 NOTE: When tightening the t-bolt clamp, make sure it covers the notches on the midpipe inlet.
