INSTALLATION

Please refer to your bike's factory service manual for disassembly/installation information. Typically, you should retain all factory screws, hardware, and grilles when upgrading your bike to a KICKER system. The KICKER PSC65 is compatible with factory locations using the included gaskets. If you are doing a custom installation, be careful not to drill into wiring or vehicle mechanisms. You are solely responsible for securely mounting the speakers. Use the included grilles and screws only when performing a custom installation.

1. Remove your motorcycle's instrument panel according to the manufacturer's service manual.

2. Remove factory speakers.

Remove the screws securing the factory speakers.

Remove the speaker connectors while removing the factory speaker.

NOTE: 2014 Harley Davidson - It is necessary to remove the outer fairing and speaker housings.



3. Install PSC65 in factory location.

Connect the factory speaker connectors to the PSC65 terminals. Mount the PSC65 to the desired location with the proper gasket and secure using the factory hardware. Re-install your bike's access panel in the reverse order you disassembled it.
