
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Part Number: TB-1016

Congratulations, you have purchased the finest air filter that money can buy. With proper care, this filter can last many seasons. This filter can be used in a stock machine, with no modifications required. If any engine modifications have been made tuning/jetting adjustments may be required. There are special installation instructions, so please follow the procedures outlined below to ensure the K&N[®] air filter seals properly.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Remove stock air filter.
- 2. Clean any sealing surfaces from any dust or debris that may be present.
- 3. Using supplied K&N[®] sealing grease, apply a small bead of grease in the air box, where the halves of the air box come together. This will ensure that the K&N[®] air filter will seal over the gap in the air box where the air box matting surfaces come together. See Fig. 1
- 4. Before installing K&N[®] air filter into air box, apply a small bead of grease to the perimeter of the sealing surface of the K&N[®] air filter. See Fig. 2
- 5. Install K&N[®] air filter.

THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.



CLEANING:

K&N Engineering, Inc., suggests checking the air filter element periodically for excessive dirt build-up. Depending on your driving conditions, we recommend cleaning your air filter every 50,000 miles. To clean and re-oil, purchase our filter Recharger[®] service kit, part number 99-5050 or 99-5000 and follow the easy instructions.
