GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING LOAD EQUALIZERS:

The High-Intensity L.E.D. Bulb is a replacement for stock incandescent bulbs. In many cases, installation does not affect operation of the vehicles lighting. In some cases, the flash rate may be affected and a load equalizer may be necessary.

TURN SIGNAL APPLICATIONS:

- '11-later Softail, '12-later Dyna, '14-later Sportster and Touring do not require load equalizers.
- '10-earlier Softail, '11-earlier Dyna, '13-earlier Touring and Sportster require a load equalizer. We recommend our Self-Regulating Load Equalizer (P/N 5498, sold separately).
- For other makes and models, if the turn signal flash rate is fast or erratic, it will be necessary to add a load equalizer.

TAILLIGHT APPLICATIONS:

- Load equalizers are not required for any taillight applications.

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

STEP 2 Installation will vary depending on application.

- Remove taillight or turn signal lens to gain access to bulb.
- Remove existing bulb from socket.
- High-Intensity Bulbs are slightly larger than typical 1157 bulbs. Ensure adequate clearance.
- Install High-Intensity Bulb into socket. Test for proper function.
- Install load equalizer if necessary.
- Reinstall lens.
