ENSURE THAT THE FOLLOWING PARTS HAVE BEEN INCLUDED IN THE KIT:

- 1 Left Front Bracket
- 1 Left Rear Bracket
- 1 Right Front Bracket
- 1 Right Rear Bracket

- 1 Hardware Kit, containing:
 - 4 Shoulder Bolts
 - 4 Lock Nuts

Hex wrench set, combo wrench set

- STEP 1
- Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.
- STEP 2

Refer to PIC 2. Starting on the left (clutch) side, remove the existing floorboards and hardware. Set floorboard and hardware aside, they will be reused.

Note: Pay attention to how the hardware is installed and how the floorboard is mounted. You will be reinstalling these items in reverse order in a later step.

- STEP 3
- Locate provided Left Front and Rear brackets, two (2) shoulder bolts, and (2) lock nuts.


Note: Refer to PIC 3. Take note of the stampings made on the inside of the brackets for assistance on determining sides.

LF = Left Front (clutch side), LR = Left Rear (clutch side)

RF = Right Front (brake side), RR = Right Rear (brake side)

STEP 4

Refer to PIC 4. Align and place the LF Bracket on the front floorboard mount, and the LR Bracket on the rear floorboard mount. Insert provided shoulder bolts, from the front-side of the bike, through the aligned mounting holes.

STEP 5 Refer to PIC 5. Fasten the brackets to the floorboard mounts using the

provided Lock Nuts. Fully tighten hardware.

STEP 6 Refer to PIC 6. Locate the floorboard and hardware that was removed in

Step 2. Install the floorboard to the relocation brackets in the reverse

order of which it was removed. Fully tighten hardware.

STEP 7 Repeat steps 2 through 6 on the right (brake) side.
