STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

STEP 2

Refer to PIC 1 and 2. Locate one (1) of the provided Lower Door Pockets.

STEP 3

Refer to PIC 3 and 4. Remove door from fairing lower.

Note: If using a flat head screw driver for the removal of the fairing lower door, wrap it in masking tape before using it to prevent damage to the motorcycle and it's parts.

STEP 4

Refer to PIC 5. Place the removed door into the backside of the Fairing Lower Door Pocket, leading with the bottom edge of the door first. Slide the two (2) bottom plastic bosses through the bottom button holes of the pocket.

STEP 5

Refer to PIC 6. Gently pull the top of the pocket up and over the top portion of the fairing lower door. Insert the top plastic boss of the door through the top button hole of the pocket. Adjust the pocket so that it is fully wrapped around the door's edges. Fasten the straps together.

STEP 6 Refer to PIC 7. Align the plastic bosses of the fairing lower door over

the mounting holes of the fairing lower. Press the door and pocket

assembly into place.

STEP 7 Repeat steps 2 through 6 for the opposite side.
