1 Dash Console

Hex wrench set, Phillips screw driver

PICTURES SHOWN ARE OF THE CHROME PARTS. INSTALLATION OF THE BLACK PARTS WILL BE THE SAME.

STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

STEP 2

Remove the seat and hardware. Set all aside; they will be reused later.

Remove existing dash console and hardware. Set the hardware aside; it will be reused later.

Remove the gaskets, mounting bracket, and hardware from dash console. Set all aside; they will be reused.

Note: Refer to your motorcycle's service manual for assitance in removal of the seat and dash console.

STEP 3

Refer to PIC 1. Locate Nasi Dash Console. Locate the gaskets that were removed in Step 2 and place it on the bottom side edges of the console. The gaskets should be positioned a 1/2" from the rear end of the console.

STEP 4

Refer to PIC 2. Locate the mounting bracket and hardware that was removed in Step 2 and fasten it to the console.





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STEP 5 Refer to PIC 3. Align and place the dash on the fuel tank. Fasten the console down to the fuel tank using hardware that was removed in Step

2.

Note: Be careful that the gaskets do not move out of place before fasten-

ing it down.

STEP 6 Place exisiting or new gas cap into dash console.

STEP 7 Reattach the seat.
