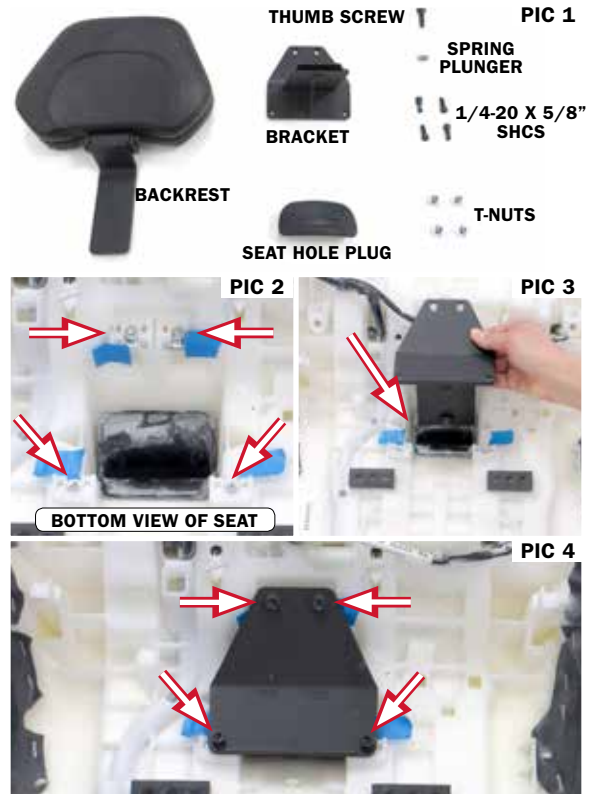

Hex wrench set, flat blade screw driver, painters masking tape, loctite

- STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.
- STEP 2** Remove side covers and unfasten the seat. Disconnect the seat's electrical harness from the motorcycle. Remove the existing seat. Place it on a flat clean surface.
- Note: See motorcycle's service manual for additional assistance.*
- STEP 3** On the bottom side of the seat, unfasten and remove existing seat hole plug. Set it aside, it will **NOT** be reused.
- STEP 4** Located provided Bracket, four (4) T-Nuts, and four (4) Socket Head Cap Screws. Apply a small amount of loctite to each of the screws.
- STEP 5** Refer to PIC 2. Carefully align and slide the four (4) T-Nuts over the mounting holes located around the opening of the seat hole. Be sure the T-nuts are flat side down. Place a small amount of tape over an edge of the aligned T-Nuts to hold them in place. Do not cover the mounting holes of the T-Nuts.
- STEP 6** Refer to PIC 3. Align the mounting plate of the bracket with the T-Nuts. Insert the bracket through the seat hole and press down on it firmly. The bracket will be a tight fit.
- STEP 7** Refer to PIC 4. Secure the bracket in place using the provided four (4) Socket Head Cap Screw. Fully tighten hardware. Be careful not to let the T-Nuts rotate as you tighten the screws.



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**STEP 8** Reconnect the seat's electrical harness to the motorcycle and reinstall the seat. Reinstall the side covers once the seat is fully installed.

**STEP 9** Refer to PIC 5. Locate provided Spring Plunger. From the top side of the seat, press back and down on the hole located in between the drive and passenger seat to gain easy access to the bracket. Insert and fasten the Spring Plunger into the mounting hole of the Bracket.

*Note: Over tightening of the Spring Plunger will cause difficulty with moving the seat up and down.*

**STEP 10** Located provided Backrest and test first it into the Bracket. Adjust the Spring Plunger as needed.

**STEP 11** Refer to PIC 6. Locate provided Seat Hole Plug. Set it into the seat, covering the backrest Bracket.

**STEP 12** Refer to PIC 7. Locate provided Backrest. Insert the Backrest through the Seat Plug and into the Bracket. The Backrest should click into place once inserted into the Bracket. Adjust the height of the Backrest by pushing it down or pulling it up.

**STEP 13** Refer to PIC 8. Locate provided Thumb Screw and apply a small amount of loctite to it. On the backside of the Backrest insert the Thumb Screw into the mounting hole.

**STEP 14** Adjust the angle of the Backrest by tightening or loosening the Thumb Screw.
