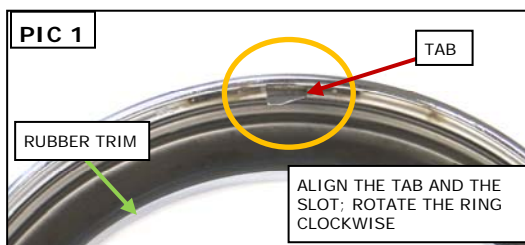
STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

NOTICE Avoid damage to the motorcycle. Protect painted surfaces with a soft cloth or service cover.

STEP 2 Locate and remove the screw from the bottom side of the existing headlamp trim ring; set it aside, it will be reused.

STEP 3 Rotate the trim ring counterclockwise, then carefully pull it straight out; set it aside, it will not be reused.

STEP 4 Refer to **PIC 1**. On the backside of the Chrome Headlamp Trim Ring, locate the tab at the top ; ensure that the rubber trim remains in place; align the tab with the slot on the fairing; rotate the Trim Ring clockwise until the screw hole on the bottom aligns.



STEP 5 Secure the Trim Ring with the screw removed in **STEP 2**. **DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN THE SCREW.**
