

  - 1 #10-32 x 5/8" Socket Head Cap Screw
  - 2 8" Black Cable Ties
  - 3 4" Black Cable Ties
  - 1 Alcohol Pad

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn **IGN OFF**. Allow the engine and exhaust system to cool. Remove the main fuse.
- STEP 2 Remove the retaining clips that secure the clutch line to the right down tube.
- STEP 3 (Twin Cooled™ models skip to STEP 4): Using warm soapy water and a clean rag, remove all dirt and debris from the down tube cross brace; allow the area to dry completely.

Wipe the cross brace with the included alcohol pad to remove any wax or polish; allow the area to dry completely.

Test fit the included Down Tube Brace Cover; remove the Cover.

Use your fingernail to rub the adhesive backing; this will activate the adhesive. Remove and discard the backing.

Align the Cover; press into place for one minute; full bonding will occur after 24 hours.

- STEP 4 Remove and discard the rubber tank tab cover and the front screw from both sides of the fuel tank.
- STEP 5 Snap the included down tube covers into place.
- STEP 6 Refer to PIC 1. Apply the included foam pads as shown.

### NOTICE

Ensure proper adhesion of this product. Remove all grease, oil, bugs, dirt, and other debris (including wax and polish) from the installation area. Kuryakyn will not provide warranty coverage on products or components lost or damaged due to improper installation.

Do not attempt this installation in temperatures below 50°F (10°C). Proper adhesive bonding ONLY occurs above 50°F (10°C).

STEP 7 Turn the handlebars all the way to the right. Align the LEFT Cover with the fuel tank tab; insert one of the included 5/16"-18 x 1-1/4" Button Socket Cap Screw and Flat

Washer through the Cover and begin threading it into the threaded frame hole; leave the screw finger tight to allow for adjustment. Repeat for the right side.




STEP 9 Locate one of the included #8-32 x 1/2" Socket Head Cap Screws and Left Down Tube Cover Clamp. Insert the Screw through the clamp; begin threading it into the Cover; leave finger tight for now.

Repeat for the right side.

STEP 10 Finish tighten the all of the screws; ensure that all wiring, hoses, and cables are secured out of harm's way with the included Cable Ties.




Secure the wiring away from moving parts, pinch points, or extreme heat. Kuryakyn will not provide warranty coverage on any electrical component that fails due to pinched, crimped, broken, abraded, melted, or frayed wires.





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STEP 11 Secure the clutch line to the right down tube with the retaining clips.



ENSURE THAT THE CLUTCH CABLE, WIRING OR ANY OTHER COMPONENT OF THE MOTORCYCLE IS NOT PINCHED OR STRETCHED AT ANY POINT WHEN THE HANDLEBARS ARE TURNED TO THEIR FULL STOP POSITION ON EITHER SIDE. STRETCHED OR PINCHED COMPONENTS CAN CAUSE LOSS OF CONTROL THAT COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

NOTICE

It is the end user's responsibility to ensure that all fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Kuryakyn will not provide warranty coverage on products or components lost or damaged due to improper installation or lack of maintenance. Periodic inspection and maintenance are required on all fasteners.
