STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

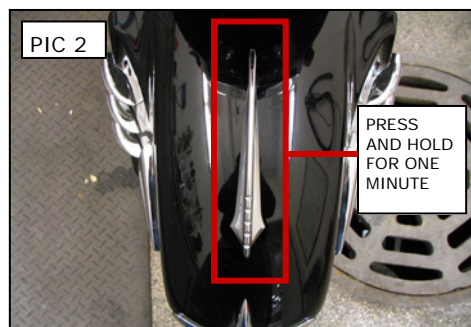
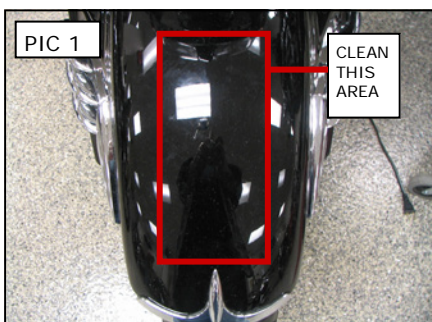
STEP 2 Remove any grease or debris from the installation area with soapy water and a clean rag; rinse and allow the area to dry completely PIC 1. Clean the area with the included alcohol cleaning pad to remove any residue; allow the area to dry completely.

ATTENTION! Thoroughly clean the area of grease, oil, dirt, or other debris to ensure proper adhesion. Kuryakyn WILL NOT warranty any parts lost due to improper installation.

ATTENTION! The adhesive may not correctly bond if applied at temperatures less than 50°F. Do not attempt this installation in temperatures less than 50°F. Rub the backing on the adhesive strip to activate the adhesive before applying.

ATTENTION! Fully compress the front fork and ensure there is no contact between the fairing and the ornament.

STEP 3 Test fit the Spear to the front fender. Make any reference marks with a non-permanent marker or masking tape. Rub the backing on the adhesive strip to activate the adhesive before applying. Remove the adhesive backing. Press the ornament into place for 1 minute to ensure proper adhesion. Full bond strength will occur within 24 hours. PIC 2
