# **TOOLS SUGGESTED**

Set of Hex Wrenches, Combination Wrenches

#### **PROCEDURE**

**STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition and allow the engine to cool.

WARNING! YOU WILL BE WORKING AROUND THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST SYSTEM DURING INSTALLATION. ENSURE THAT THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST SYSTEM HAVE FULLY COOLED TO PREVENT INJURY.

## **FOR '91-UP MODELS**

**STEP 2** Remove the screw and washer that secure the lower stabilizer link as shown in PIC. 1; they will be used again.

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**STEP 3** Place the mounting bracket ('91-'08 models) over the stabilizer and start the screw and washer as shown in PIC. 2; do not tighten yet.

**STEP 4** Place the cover on the mounting bracket and line the holes in the cover up with the mounting holes in the bracket. Check for clearance between the cover and the frame; adjust the bracket as needed to achieve adequate clearance.

**STEP 5** Remove the cover and tighten the screw; torque to 24 ft. lbs.

**STEP 6** Place the cover on the bracket and secure with the two screws from the hardware kit. (See PIC. 3)

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including preassembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.

#### **FOR '09-UP MODELS**

**STEP 1** Loosen the 2 screws shown in PIC 4.

**STEP 2** As shown in PIC 5, slide the Mounting Bracket ('09-up models) behind the screw heads (and washer on rear screw). Press down on the Bracket and tighten the screws.


**NOTE** If there is no engine guard installed on the motorcycle, use the supplied  $3/18-16 \times 1$ " Button Socket Cap Screw and spacer in the front hole. Place the Spacer behind the bracket and thread the screw in to the hole.

**STEP 3** Place the Cover on the Mounting Bracket and line the holes in the cover up with the mounting holes in the Bracket. Check for clearance between the cover and the frame.

**STEP 4** As shown in pic 3, secure the cover with the two  $10-24 \times 1/2$ " screws from the hardware kit.


