- **STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.
- **STEP 2** Remove any grease or debris from the rear fender installation area with soapy water and a clean rag; rinse and allow the area to dry completely. Clean the area with the included alcohol cleaning pad to remove any residue; allow the area to dry completely.
- ATTENTION! Thoroughly clean the area of grease, oil, dirt, or other debris to ensure proper adhesion. Küryakyn WILL NOT warranty any parts lost due to improper installation.
- ATTENTION! The adhesive may not correctly bond if applied at temperatures less than 50°F. Do not attempt this installation in temperatures less than 50°F.Rub the backing on the adhesive strip to activate the adhesive before applying.
- **STEP 3** Test fit the fender tip to the rear fender. There is a lip on the trim that will fit to the bottom of the fender PIC 1. Rub the backing on the adhesive strip to activate the adhesive before applying. Remove the adhesive backing. Press the trim into place for 1 minute to ensure proper adhesion. Full bond strength will occur within 24 hours. PIC 2
