STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the

installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the

ignition.

WARNING! YOU WILL BE WORKING AROUND THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST

SYSTEM DURING INSTALLATION. ENSURE THAT THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST SYSTEM HAVE FULLY COOLED TO PREVENT

INJURY.

CAUTION! These boards are not intended as a step. Passenger and rider

should be aware that they should be used as a footrest only.

NOTE: Fits various applications, requires splined adapter mount, sold separately.

Küryakyn NOTE: This product should not be installed in place of a footpeg on a peg mount secured with a

single fastener and no anti-rotation mechanism. This product will apply too much force

and loosen the mount from the bike.

STEP 2 Remove the OEM pegs from the bike.

STEP 3 Separate the footboard from the mount by removing the 3/8"-16" socket head cap screw from the wide end of the board

and the 1/4"-20" socket head cap screw from the narrow end. Be very careful not to lose the detent ball and spring located

between the board and mount. See PIC.1.

STEP 4 Loosely attach your adapter (sold separately) to the footboard

mount with the 5/16"-18 X 7/8" Socket Head Cap Screw provided as shown in PIC.2. Shown is the splined adapter, Küryakyn P/N 8813 for Kawasaki. Your adapter may look slightly different but must have the splines on the inner face of the

adapter to properly mate with the splines on the footboard

ATTENTION! Ensure that the supplied anti-seize is applied to all threaded fasteners before installation; this will make

future removal of the fasteners easier.

STEP 5 Mount the adapter to the bike using the OEM peg mounting

hardware. Determine the angle that will provide you the most comfort without interfering with other nearby components. Fully tighten the 5/16"-18 X 7/8" Socket Head Cap Screw securing

the footboard mount to the adapter.

CAUTION! Ensure that the installation of this product does not interfere with the proper

operation of the motorcycle before riding.

STEP 6 Place a dab of grease in the recess where the detent ball seats in the footboard mount to help

hold it in place during reassembly. Attach the footboard to the footboard mount in reverse order

as they were disassembled in STEP 3.

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not

issue a warranty on components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance

may be required.
