PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition and allow the engine to cool.

- **STEP 2** Remove the nylon insert nut on the front of the shift linkage; disconnect the front end of the shift linkage from the shifter lever. Secure the shift linkage up and out of the way during the rest of the installation.
- **STEP 3** Remove the stock fastener on the left side of the crankcase as shown in PIC.1.
- **STEP 4** Position the Cylinder Base Cover for Softail in place and secure it with the included Socket Head Cap Screw 96" and 103" engines use the 3-1/4" long screw, 110" engines use the 4" long screw . Torque the fastener to 15-19 ft. lbs.
- **STEP 5** Push the Hot Spot into the head of the new fastener.

- **STEP 6** Reconnect the shift linkage and shift lever; tighten the nut.
- **STEP 7** Check for proper clearance before operating the motorcycle.

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including preassembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
