**STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let cool.

### SUGGESTED GUIDELINES FOR INSTALLATION

- The shift cover will fit over most OEM rubber shifter sleeves, but will need to be removed on others.
- PIC.1 shows the OEM shifter sleeve on a 2004 Yamaha Road Star 1700 as an example of an OEM shifter sleeve that needs to be removed.
- If you need to remove your OEM shifter sleeve, it is suggested that you make a few wraps of black electrical tape around the bare shift peg. See PIC.2.
- Dry fit the cover and lightly tighten the setscrew to make sure the rubber does not flare out. If the rubber does flare, simply remove the cover and remove some of the tape. Repeat until the peg fits with out flared rubber.
- Remove the shift cover and apply a little super glue on the inside of the new cover being careful not to get any glue on surrounding chrome or painted surfaces.
- Slide the shift cover on. Position the cover so setscrew will be located on the bottom side of the peg. Tighten the setscrew snugly, but do not over tighten, as this may crack the cover. Allow the glue to dry overnight.



**ATTENTION!** It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Kuryakyn will not issue a warranty on components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
