
Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

#### **INSTALL THE FRONT PEG ADAPTERS:**

- STEP 2 Use a small flat-blade screwdriver to remove the E-clip from the footrest pivot-pin; save it for later.
- **STEP 3** Remove the pin and existing footrest; save the pin, E-clip, and return spring for later use.
- Refer to PIC 1. Assemble the return spring in the new Splined Adapter as shown. Insert one of the included Spacers as shown; the Spacer can be inserted on the top or bottom side allowing for approx. 1/4" of height adjustment; the Spacer will secure the spring in the Adapter.
- **STEP 5** Insert the long leg of the spring in the mount hole as shown in PIC 2. Press the Adapter in to align the holes; secure with the pin and E-clip.
- **STEP 6** Repeat for the other side.
- **STEP 7** Finish the installation by following the procedures included with the footrests (sold separately).

#### **INSTALL THE REAR PEG ADAPTERS:**

Note: Ensure that the detent ball and spring are secured after the pivot pin is removed; the detent ball is very small and easy to lose.

STEP 8 Use a small flat-blade screwdriver to remove the E-clip from the footrest pivot-pin; save it for later. Carefully remove the existing footrest; save the detent ball and spring for later use.

STEP 9 Insert the detent ball in the Adapter on the upper-side to prevent it from falling out during installation. Sandwich the spring and Adapter in between the mount on the bike as shown in PIC 3 and 4.

**STEP 10** Refer to PIC 4. Align the holes and secure with the pin and E-clip.

**STEP 11** Repeat for the other side.

**STEP 12** Finish the installation by following the procedures included with the footrests (sold separately).
