Set of Hex Wrenches, Set of Combination Wrenches, Torque Wrench (IN LBS), Socket Set, Blue Thread Locker

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn **IGN OFF.** Allow the engine and exhaust system to cool. Remove the main fuse.

NOTICE	These installation instructions contain important information. Ensure that the end user receives this copy and is aware of its importance for future use.
STEP 2 Remove the existing air cleaner cover. Set aside, it will not be reused.	
NOTE:	If you have a Küryakyn Street Sleeper II air cleaner kit installed (P/N 9530 or P/N 9537) you will also need to remove the existing X Vibration Dampener Assembly and the Composure Strap. These will not be reused with the Alley Cat cover.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 3 Refer to PIC 1. For Küryakyn filters: Insert the 5/16" (larger) end of the stud through the outside of the Alley Cat Cover. PIC 1

Refer to **PIC 2 and 3.** For Screamin' Eagle and Arlen Ness Filters: Rub the adhesive backing on the foam pads. Peel the backing off the pads and attach them to the smooth side of the Stay Ring. Place the black plastic Stay Ring over the end of the stud protruding from the inside of the Cover.

- STEP 4Refer to PIC 4. Place a drop of blue thread locker on the longer end of the Double-Ended
Stud. Place the Alley Cat Cover over the Filter and secure to the existing Spider Bracket with
the Stud. Torque to 36-60 in/lbs. The Stud may need to be loosened a bit to line up the flats
on the Stud with the dowels on the Cover as shown in PIC 14.
- STEP 5 Refer to PIC 4. Align the indents in the Nylon Ratchet with the dowels on the Cover as shown.
- STEP 6Refer to PIC 5 and 6. Place a drop of blue thread locker on the exposed threads of the Stud;
thread the Tri-Bar fastener onto the Stud. There are teeth on the Ratchet Ring that engage the
Tri-Bar teeth. The Tri-Bar only needs to be finger tight! DO NOT over tighten it!
- **STEP 7** Ensure the tightness of all related fasteners, check for hose clearance and check throttle for correct operation, making sure it returns properly, before starting the bike. Reinstall the main fuse.

NOTICE

Proper tuning is important. Carbureted bikes should be re-jetted and fuel injected bikes should be tuned with a TTS MasterTune tuning system or Vance & Hines FP3 by an experienced tuner, on a dyno, with an exhaust gas analyzer.

It is the end user's responsibility to ensure that all fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Kuryakyn will not provide warranty coverage on products or components lost or damaged due to improper installation or lack of maintenance. Periodic inspection and maintenance are required on all fasteners.
