- Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.
- STEP 2 If applicable, remove windshield. Refer to motorcycle's service manual for assistance.
- **STEP 3** Refer to PIC 1. Starting on the right side front fork, remove existing hardware from the outer edge of the front fork leg. Set hardware aside, it will be reused.

Note: Process will vary between models, as some models may have a lighting system connected at these points. Refer to motorcycle's service manual for additional assistance.

STEP 4 Refer to PIC 2. Locate Right Tie-Down. Align the top hole of the Tie-Down with the top hole of the fork leg. Insert one of the screws that was removed from Step 3. Lightly tighten hardware.

Note: If model has light system positioned over these holes, the Tie-Down bracket will be placed in between the fork leg and light system.







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STEP 5

Refer to PIC 3 and 4. Align the bottom hole of the Tie-Down with the bottom hole of the fork leg. Insert the other screw into the aligned holes and tighten. Fully tighten both screws. Refer to service manual for torque specification.

Note: If model has light system positioned over these holes, the Tie-Down bracket will be placed in between the fork leg and light system.

STEP 6 Repeat steps 3 through 5 for the left side.

STEP 7 If applicable, reinstall the windshield.
