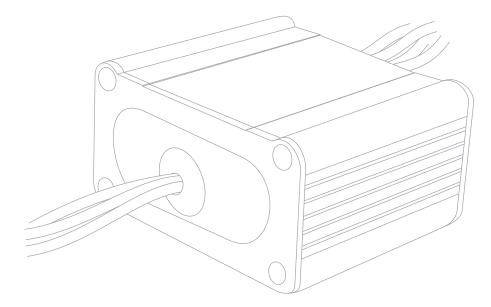


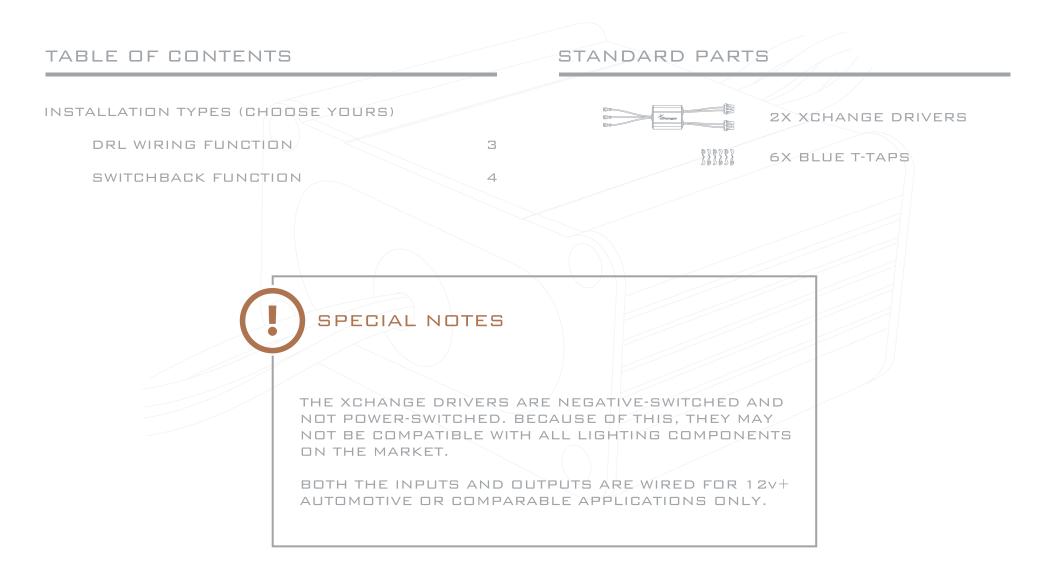

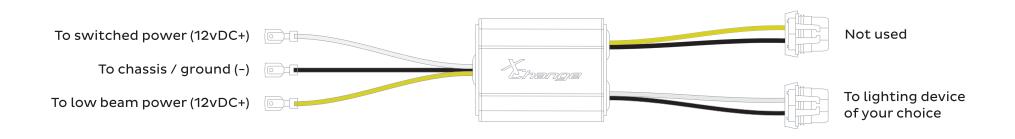

THIS WIRING SCHEMATIC IS USED FOR THE INSTALLATIONS WHERE A DRL SIGNAL IS NEEDED BUT DID NOT PREVIOUSLY EXIST. WHEN THE CAR IS TURNED ON, THE SIGNAL FROM THE VEHICLE TURNS THE XCHANGE DRIVER ON, THUS TURNING THE LIGHTING DEVICE OF YOUR CHOICE ON AS YOUR DAYTIME RUNNING LIGHT. ONCE THE LOW BEAMS ARE TURNED ON, THE DRL SIGNAL IS DROPPED, AND RETURNS ONLY WHEN THE LOW BEAMS ARE TURNED OFF WITH THE VEHICLE STILL RUNNING.



THIS WIRING SCHEMATIC IS USED FOR THE INSTALLATIONS WHERE THE RUNNING LIGHT IS ILLUMINATED CONSTANTLY BASED ON A POWER SOURCE'S SIGNAL. WHEN THE VEHICLE'S INDICATOR IS SWITCHED ON, THE ILLUMINATED LIGHTING DEVICE TURNS OFF, AND A SECOND LIGHTING DEVICE IS ILLUMINATED CONCURRENT WITH THE INDICATOR'S TIMED SEQUENCE. ONCE TURNED OFF, THE ORIGINAL RUNNING LIGHT RETURNS AFTER A BRIEF PAUSE.
