

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Yamaha Virago 700/750/1000/1100 2008-2015 - One-piece Seat

Hardware: Stock Allen bolts

Tools needed: Metric Allen wrenches

Note: This seat will not fit Virago 250 or 535 models.

Removal of stock seat:

- 1. Remove the side covers. Locate and remove the two Allen bolts from each side of the nose of the seat.
- 2. Lift the nose of the seat and slide the seat forward to remove the seat from the frame.



Installation of Mustanq seat:

Note: Be extremely careful to keep the seat's front mounting bracket from contacting the fuel tank to avoid scratching the tank.

- 1. Align the rear tab of the Mustang seat with the rearward mounting bracket on the fender, and push seat back fully to engage. A solid chop to the seat may be required to seat it fully back.
- 2. Align the front mounting brackets with the mounting holes in the frame and re-install the stock Allen screws.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
