## Mounting Suggestions: Yamaha Bolt 2013-14 Spring Solo Kit

Phillips Screwdriver, 10mm Nut Driver

Hardware included:

re Mustang Front Mounting Bracket, Seat
d: Mounting Bracket and Spring Bracket

(2) Chrome Washers, (2) Fender Washers,
(2) Flat Nylon Washers, (5) 1/4"-20x5/8" Phillips Screws
(2) 6mm Allen Screws, (1) 1/4"-28x2-1/4" Hex Screw,
(1) 1/4"-28 Nylock Nut

6mm Allen Wrench, 7/16" Socket, 7/16" Wrench

Installation of Spring Solo Kit:





Now insert the 1/4"-20 x 1/2" Phillips screw through the hole in the plate and the pouch.







On the underside of your solo seat there are three 1/4"-20 mounting locations.



Line up the three holes in the mounting plate with the holes on your seat.



Using three 1/4"-20 x 5/8" screws, attach the plate to the seat starting with the two rear locations.







Using a fender washer and a 1/4"-20 x 5/8" Phillips screw, attach the first seat spring to the mounting plate.







Make sure the offset (wider, more open) side of the spring is facing towards the front of the seat when tightening in place.



Using a 10mm socket, remove the bracket for the stock seat from the fender.



Line up the two holes of the spring bracket (supplied) with the two holes on the bike frame.

Attach the spring bracket using two 6mm chrome Allen head screws and the two chrome washers (supplied).







Now install the front seat hinge bracket by lining up the pins with the two holes in the front portion of the bike frame.





Using the screw from your stock seat, tighten the bracket using a 10mm socket.



Position nose of seat into front seat hinge bracket as shown.

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







Carefully flip up your seat making sure there is clearance between the seat springs and your fender.
