


TOOLS REQUIRED


Hex Key, 5/32" Two 7/16" Wrenches Scissor or Small Knife Phillips Screw Driver (to adjust window if necessary)



Right and Left are determined from a rider's perspective







LEFT SIDE


PREPARATION

Take precaution against paint damage while installing your windshield kit to your motorcycle. Place a heavy cloth over the front fender of your motorcycle to prevent any scratches or dents from occurring should a tool or part fall during installation.

INSTALLATION

1. Install die cut Rubber Clamp Spacers to each clamp half.

Trim the Spacer at the inside edge of Right Side Male and Female Clamp. (Scissor) Diagram A.





- 2. Put Clamps on fork.
 - A. Must hit upper triple clamp.
 - **B.** Use M6 x 12 Screw and Acorn nut to clamp together. Tighten to 10 ft. lbs. Diagram B. (Hex Key, Wrenches)

- 3. Install windshield onto brackets using chrome spacers and flat plate, as shown in diagram C. (Hex Key, Wrenches)
- 4. Make final adjustments. Check symmetry of left and right sides and clearance. Gently turn handlebar left and right to full fork lock to assure that no interference occurs between the Hardware, turnsignals or Chrome Lowers and the gas tank.
- 5. Fully tighten socket head screws, bolts, and cap nuts.

Optional adjustment of the window. For Heavy DutyTM Windshields only.

The adjustable window is easily adjusted or changed in all National Cycle Heavy Duty Windshields. Loosen the 6 cap nuts on the vertical chrome strips. Replace or adjust the window. Tighten cap nuts to 2 - 4 ft. lbs. (2.7 - 5.4 Nm), torque pressure.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

To clean the screen, wash with a clean soft cloth and plenty of warm water and, if necessary, a non-abrasive soap such as dishwashing liquid. Flannel or soft chamois make good cleaning cloths. **Paint, glue residue or grease removal:** Moisten cotton wad with naphtha or turpentine followed by a wash as above.

National Cycle **Shield Wash™** (N1401-01) makes a good daily cleaner and comes with a handy travel-size bottle. Shield Wash is safe for all windshields and helmet visors.

Do not clean polycarbonate in hot sun or high temperatures. Do not clean the screen with household glass cleaners.

Do not allow brake fluid, alcohol, or strong solvents to contact the screen.

RAIN REPELLENT

Do not use rain protective products made for glass. We recommend National Cycle's **RainZip®** (N1410-01) to keep your windscreen clear in rainy weather.
