MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1- Mount the bridle (7), previously opened, in the swing arm brace (6) that goes over the chainguard, as the left hand figure shows (a sticker foam is supplied to place in the interior). On the opposite side, it is needed to remove the guide (2) of the rear brake line (5), and place the supplied hardware (3) in between the swing arm (1) and the guide (2) in order that sticks out from the swing arm on the closest part to the engine. Use the orginal fastener (4), as the right hand figure shows.
- 2- Place the well nuts in the hugger drills.
- *3- Mount the hugger using the allen fastener M6x20 in the bridle, and the M6x15 in the hardware, jointly with the special nuts.*
- 4- Adjust the hugger with the tire through the regulation that the iron fittings offer, and tighten them all.
- 5- Check them periodically, and tighten the fixations.
- 6- In case your motorcycle has other accessories, observe that it does not interfere with the hugger.
