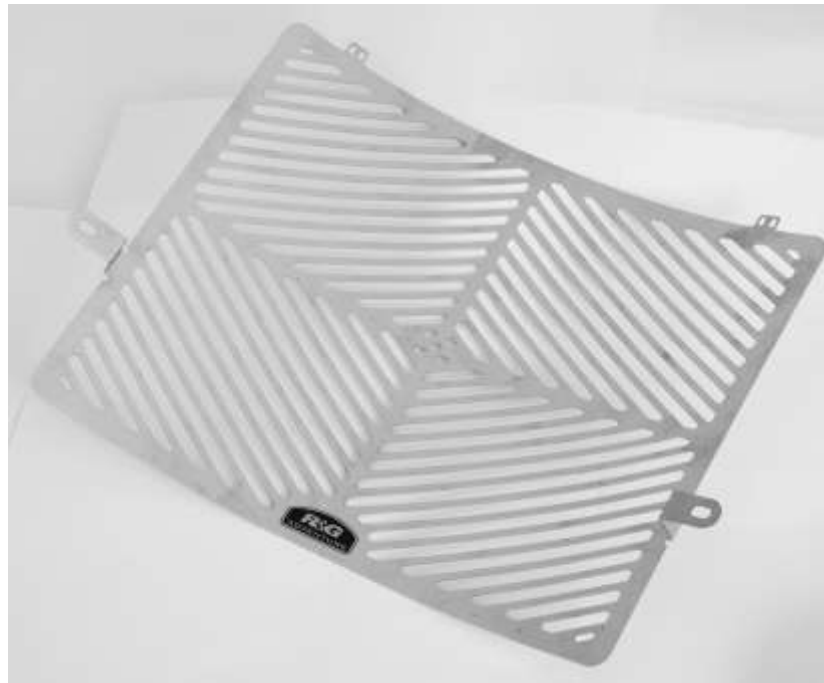




Fitting Instructions for SRG0008 Radiator Guard
KTM 1190 ADVENTURE 2013



In This Kit There Should Be
1x Radiator Guard (SRG0008)
2x M5 x 16mm Long Button Head Bolts
2x M5 Washers
2x S0637 Spacers (4.5mm long)
2x Cable Tie
2x 100mm Lengths of self-adhesive Foam

TOOLS REQUIRED

- T20 Torx socket and wrench.
 - 3mm A/F allen key.
 - Cable cutters.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the radiator guard to the bike cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the radiator guard frame, so that they sit between the radiator guard and the radiator.
- Remove the two Torx bolts that secure the radiator surround plastic in place on either side of the radiator, as shown in picture 1.
- Take the R&G Radiator Guard and locate one washer over one M5 x 16mm long button head bolt. Now insert this through one of the mounting holes on the radiator guard, before fitting one spacer onto the exposed end of the thread (larger diameter first), as shown in picture 2. Repeat this for the mounting hole on the other side of the radiator guard.
- Ensure these spacers remain in position and offer the R&G Radiator Guard into position. This will need to be gently slid up to ensure the top brackets fit behind the plastic.
- The bolts and spacer will now align with the mounting holes on the plastic. Locate the bolts and spacers, before tightening, as shown in picture 3.
- With the upper mounts sitting behind the plastic, insert one cable tie on each side and loop around the radiator mount and then tighten, as shown in picture 4.
- Ensure all bolts are tightened evenly and the radiator is correctly mounted.
