License Plate Mounted Flag Holder

For all Motorcycles with a vertically mounted rigid (not plastic) license plate mount

- 1. The flag holder is designed to mount to the existing license plate holder. The existing plate holder must be vertical and rigid (i.e. made of metal and not plastic) to support the weight and vibration from the flags and poles.
- 2. Remove the license plate. Install the flag holder and poles between the license plate and its mount or behind the license plate mount. If your plate uses plastic bolts and nuts you MUST replace them with metal bolts and nuts (you can find nice stainless steel or chrome ones at most hardware stores). Center the flag holder and license plate on the mounting bracket and tighten the bolts securely
- 3. Check the poles base nut and locking nut for tightness. Remove the top finial nut and two plastic clips from the poles. Slide your flags over the poles, and then, after adding a drop of blue Loc-Tite Medium Strength thread locker, re-attach and tighten the finial nut. Press the plastic clips over the material of the flag and pole using one at the bottom and top of the flag.
