Flag Holder And License Plate Mount

**For 2010 and newer Harley-Davidson FLHX Street Glide,
FLTR & FLTRX Road Glide, and Road Glide Custom**

1. The flag holder is designed to replace the existing plastic license plate holder. Remove the license plate. Remove the turn signal assembly by removing the two ½" bolts located on the inside of rear fender. Place a folded towel over the fender to protect it, then turn the signal/license mount assembly over and lay it on the towel.
2. Remove the bolts holding the license plate bracket. Replace the plastic holder with the new license/flag bracket using the screws removed earlier, and then tighten securely. Carefully turn the signal/license mount around while taking care not to scratch the fender, then reinstall the turn signal/flag mount using the bolts removed earlier and tighten securely.
3. Check the pole's base nut and locking nut for tightness. Remove the top finial nut and two plastic clips from the poles. Slide your flags over the poles, and then, after adding a drop of blue Loc-Tite Medium Strength thread locker to the finial nut, re-attach and tighten the finial nut. Press the plastic clips over the material of the flag and pole using one at the bottom and top of the flag.
