Warning: Will not fit 2001-2012 FL Touring models with stock and/or stock style exhaust pipes.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- I. Turn your motorcycle off and disconnect the battery.
- Place an oil pan underneath the cam cover area and remove the existing cam cover. (refer to the HD service manual if necessary). Removal of the exhaust sytem may be required on some models.
- 3. Once the existing cam cover is removed, clean all gasket/mounting surfaces and wipe out excess oil. Note: Do not use any harsh chemicals such as brake cleaner or acetone during cleaning.
- 4. Using supplied gasket, install the RSD Clarity Cam cover and hand tighten bolts to hold it in place. NOTE: Upon assembly use blue 243 loctite on the I/4" fasteners.

NOTE: Make sure the inside of the Lexan window is clean prior to installation. Clean with Plexus if necessary.

- 5. Torque the I/4-20 x I" bolts to I05 in-lbs using the torque sequence shown in Fig A below.
- 6. Reconnect the battery and check the oil level. Add oil if necessary per the HD service manual.
- 7. Reinstall the exhaust system if necessary.

Caution: The Clarity Cam cover may interfere with some exhaust sytems. When installing, please verify there is an adequate distance of at least 5/16" between the Clarity window and the exhaust pipe to allow adequate air flow and cooling. Failure to verify the gap distance may result in severe damage to the Clarity windows, window discoloration, and potential oil leakage.





TECHNICAL BULLETIN



The RSD Clarity Cam Cover 0177-2003 contains two pre-installed Lexan polycarbonate windows. These windows are very resistant to almost everything a motorcycle will be exposed to, however, extra care and preparation must be taken when installing the cam cover near the exhaust system. The Lexan polycarbonate windows must be at least 5/16" away from the exhaust pipe to insure the temperature does not exceed the capabilities of the Lexan. Additional clearance is recommended to preserve the optical clarity of the Lexan window as well as reducing the amount of heat introduced to the engine from the exhaust. Take measurements when installing the exhaust system and make sure that the exhaust NEVER contacts the Lexan windows, bolts, or the aluminum cam cover. lexan is very durable but it must be treated just like any plastic and cannot come into contact with the exhaust pipes. The Lexan windows just like any plastic will melt if in direct contact with the exhaust pipe. If the Lexan windows have less than adequate clearance premature discoloration, cracking, or melting may occur causing severe failure and/or possible injury to the rider. RSD recommends the use of "high pipes" or exhaust that runs above the cam cover which eliminates any potential exhaust contact.

TECHNICAL GUIDELINES FOR CLARITY CAM COVER:

- I. THERE MUST BE AT LEAST 5/16" AIR GAP BETWEEN THE EXHAUST AND THE LEXAN WINDOWS, BOLTS, AND COVER.
- 2. ABSOLUTELY NO CONTACT BETWEEN THE LEXAN WINDOWS, BOLTS, OR ALUMINUM CAM COVER.
- 3. DO NOT USE BRAKE CLEANER, ACETONE, OR ANY HARSH CHEMICALS DURING INSTALLATION.
- 4. USE PLEXXUS CLEANER FOR CLEANING. IF ANY OTHER CLEANERS ARE USED READ THE LABEL TO VERIFY COMPATIBLILTY WITH LEXAN.

If we replace it, we may replace it with a reconditioned one of the same design.
